There has been a lot in the media lately about the teaching of Reading in schools. At St Bernadette's, we are constantly evaluating our programs to ensure they are based on current research and are best suited to our students. This year we have adopted a new phonics program titled UFLI Foundations - an explicit and systematic phonics program. To ensure all staff are confident in using this program, we will be having a staff development day where all staff will be trained in the delivery of this program. This school closure day will be help on Thursday 16th May. There will be no school on this day.

This weekend, all Christians enter into a most significant time of the year - the Easter Season - where we celebrate the life, death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. I encourage you to take time over these sacred and special days to recognise the true meaning of Easter – to acknowledge what Jesus did and to acknowledge God's great love for us in sacrificing his Son. 


