SCHOOL FEES/LEVIES 2025

Thank you to those families who are up-to-date with or who have paid their fees in full. I really appreciate your attention to this matter. Could all families make sure their fees/levies are paid in full by **Friday 5th December**.

SCHOOL FEES AND LEVIES FOR 2026

St Bernadette's aims to keep a Catholic Education affordable and achievable for all families who seek it for their children. At the same time, meeting the requirements and increasing costs, across multiple areas, in running a school.

Our School Fees are also influenced by the Commonwealth Department of Education's calculation of our community's ability to financially contribute to the operating costs of our school, known as the Capacity to Contribute, or CTC, which is reviewed annually.

In consultation with the School Advisory Council and Business Manager, there will be an increase in both the fees and levies. **For 2026, School Fees have been set at \$1600 and Levies at \$380.** This is an increase of \$180 in total for one child or \$4.50 a week over 40 weeks.

 Interschool Sport Yr 5/6 \$30 per student
 Graduation Yr 6 \$20 per student
 Swimming Prep - Yr 4 \$100 per student

If you have received a Health Care Card since July 2025, please bring the card to the office so that we can apply for the CSEF contribution towards your school costs.

As is always the case, any family who may have difficulty in paying the above school fees/levies, are invited and encouraged to contact the office or myself to discuss the matter.

PAYMENT PLANS FOR SCHOOL FEES/LEVIES FOR 2026

For those families who have set up a payment plan for 2025, this information will be rolled over to next year, and amounts will be adjusted according to student fees/levies for 2026.

New rules for under-16s

Popular platforms like Facebook, Instagram, Snapchat, TikTok, X, and YouTube may soon restrict account access for students under 16.

Other platforms may be added to the list impacted by the legislation.

What's still accessible

- Public content that doesn't require login.
- Educational platforms like Google Classroom and YouTube Kids.
- YouTube videos that can be viewed without signing in.

What it means for schools

- Schools may need to explore new ways to communicate with students and families.
- Teachers can still share age-appropriate educational content to support learning.
