CAMP AUSTRALIA

From January 2026, the Federal Government introduced the Child Care Subsidy (CCS) Three Day Guarantee. This change removes the activity test and provides all eligible families with at least 72 subsidised hours per fortnight.

For most families, this is a significant shift. It means their OSHC is now fully covered across a fortnight, without needing to track work hours or meet activity test requirements. Families can also access up to three days of subsidised vacation care each week.

SAFER INTERNET DAY - TUESDAY 10TH FEBRUARY


Safer Internet Day is a global day of action that brings together communities, families, schools, and organisations to raise awareness about online safety and work toward a safer internet.
